Animal tracks: marks or imprints left on the ground by wild animals

Community garden: shared space where people grow plants

Composting: the act of collecting and storing plant material and food scraps so they can decay and

be added to the soil to improve its quality

Conservation: the act of protecting Earth's natural resources for current and future generations

Conservationist: a person who acts for the protection of the environment and wildlife

Diseases: conditions of the body that cause harm to the health of an organism

Drone: small aircraft that flies by remote control without a pilot on board

Ecotourism: tourism to natural areas that is designed to support local communities and wildlife

conservation

Habitat: the natural environment where an organism lives and meets its needs for survival

Injustice: an action that is unfair or violates the rights of a person or group of people

Lawmakers: people who make laws

National Park: land set aside by the government to preserve its history or natural resources

Poacher: person whose illegally hunts or captures wild animals or plants

Recycle: to convert waste or trash into something new

Scientist: someone who studies the world around them by asking questions and trying to find

answers about the way things work

Solar panel: device that converts sunlight into electricity

Wildlife: living things in nature, not including humans or domesticated animals such as pets
